This constitution may be amended by a majority vote of the qualified voters of the Modoc Nation voting in an election called for that purpose by the Secretary of the Interior, Provided, That at least thirty percent (30%) of those entitled to vote shall cast ballots in such election. 12	This constitution may be amended by a majority vote of the qualified voters of the Modoc Nation voting in an election called for that purpose in accordance with the Modoc Election Ordinance, Provided, that at least thirty percent (30%) of those qualified to vote shall cast ballots in such election. <sup>13</sup>
Amendments to this constitution shall be proposed by a petition, signed by at least ten (10) members of the Modoc Tribal Council, or by a majority vote of the Modoc Elected Council.	Amendments to this constitution shall be proposed by a petition, signed by at least thirty (30) members of the Modoc Tribal Council, or by a majority vote of the Modoc Elected Council.
